SUMMARY MINUTES

- 1. The Board meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by President Brent Osborn.
- 2. Eric Anderson moved, and Chris Visserman seconded a motion to approve the Minutes from the Board meeting held April 27, 2023. The motion passed.

Financial Reports

- 3. The WSPEF The total cash on hand is \$1,078,935 with 4.28 months of cash on hand with an estimated 8.57 months of cash on hand in survival mode. The total AWSL/Learning Centers cash on hand is \$1,078,935.
- 4. Outdoor Schools WA cash balance as of May 31, 2023, is \$6,725,772.

Foundation Report

- 5. Two new homes have been installed at Cispus. The septic system had to be redone.
- 6. The Principal Learning Center has been accredited through 2023.
- 7. Cispus had 4,557 users and 14,534 user days. 1,344 more users than 2022. As of June 15, 2023, there was a total income for Cispus of \$660,321.42 which is 44% of the budgeted revenue with expenses of \$574,552.56 which is 43& of budgeted expenses.
- 8. New staff members have been hired for AWSL as well as Cispus.
- 9. The 2023-24 Strategic Plan for the following areas:

<u>AWSL</u>

- Hire a certificated staff member.
- Continue to pursue Gates Foundation support.
- Offer sessions more robustly across the state.
- Finalize the Leadership Scope and Sequence and market that to schools.

<u>Cispus</u>

- Develop housing options for current and future customers.
- Create programming options with the addition of a new course employee.

Outdoor School

- Two workshops per year
- Economic model supports to emerging sites through Western Washington University
- Commission study on benefits of overnight outdoor educational experiences
- Accreditation process development: Safety and Management Review
- Characteristics of high-quality outdoor school programs

Principal Learning Center

- Develop registrar protocols.
- Increase connections with university partners.
- Pilot Outdoor Education/Teaching Academy with credit opportunities

Public School Finance Support Development

- ASB custom workshops
- PTA/PTO/Booster trainings
- Learning Lab considerations: Adviser, Bookkeepers, Students, Administrators, Others
