Erin Jones, Education Consultant & Speaker

Erin Jones has been involved in and around schools for the past 26 years. She received multiple awards for teaching and leadership, recognition at the White House in March of 2013 as a “Champion of Change” and was Washington State PTA’s “Outstanding Educator” in 2015. After serving as a classroom teacher and instructional coach, Erin worked as an executive for two State Superintendents. Erin left OSPI in

2012 to work in college-access at the school district level. She later ran for State Superintendent and was the first Black woman to run for any state office in Washington state, a race she lost by a mere 1%.

Cindy is starting her 22nd year as an administrator with the Kelso School District. She was named as one of the 2021 National Digital Principals for the National Association of Secondary School Principals for her demonstration of continuous bold, creative leadership in her drive to harness the potential of new technologies to further learning goals.
